

26th Annual Top Gun Application Checklist:

Note - Submitting an application does not guarantee acceptance (note preference given to teams providing referee crews)

Complete application package must be mailed and consists of all the following documents:

- 1) Online Registration (including entering of roster) must be completed on the GotSoccer.com website link is on miramesaayso.org
- 2) Team Application form with wet signature of Regional Commissioner and others as indicated. Note only AYSO REGIONAL CHECKS are accepted (no personal or business checks accepted per AYSO guidelines)
- 3) Zero Tolerance form with wet signature of Regional Commissioner and others as indicated
- 4) Referee Information form with wet signature of Regional Commissioner and others as indicated
- 5) EAYSO tournament roster with wet signature of Regional Commissioner.
- 6) T-shirt order form
- 7) Guest Player form (only U16 & U 19 teams eligible)

Tournament board must review each team's application before a team is accepted.

If a team's application is not accepted, a refund will be issued.

Teams withdrawing 30 days or more before the tournament will be issued a full refund.

Teams withdrawing less than 30 days before the start of the tournament will only be issued a refund if a replacement team can be found.

If the tournament is canceled and cannot be rescheduled a full refund will be issued.

** No exceptions will be granted to roster limits**

Application Instructions

The deadline to apply to the tournament is **March 19th**, **2016**. Applications received by that date will be given priority for acceptance into the tournament; all others will be accepted based on any available openings.

Your application must include ALL of the following:

- Online Registration for the tournament at GotSoccer.com link is posted on miramesaayso.org website.
 Note: Team Contact Information, Roster with Jersey Numbers needs to be entered in the online portion of the registration.
- 2. Team Application Form with GotSoccer ID#, signed by the Head Coach and the Regional Commissioner.
- 3. Team eAYSO roster signed by your Regional Commissioner.
 - Roster changes will be allowed up until May 1st. All roster changes must be approved by your Regional Commissioner and must be received by the Tournament by May 1st.
 - Rosters must be comprised solely of AYSO-registered players. In Divisions U16 & U19 only, Guest players are allowed (3 maximum per team). Guest players are from another AYSO Region (submit the Guest Player Form). Players who are not registered in eAYSO for 2015-16 by March 19, 2016 MAY NOT BE INCLUDED. Divisions U10, U12 & U14 may not use Guest players.
 - Player roster limits are as follows:

U16/U19	18 players max	11-v-11 play
U14	15 players max	11-v-11 play
U12	12 players max	9-v-9 play
U10	10 players max	7-v-7 play

- 4. Referee Form, signed by your Regional Referee Administrator and Area Referee Administrator, as appropriate. If you're not planning to bring referees, indicate "NO" in the box on the Referee Form and return it without the RRA signature. Teams applying without a referee team will be placed on a waiting list.
- 5. A single **REGION CHECK** for the total amount of the Team Entry Fee and the Referee Commitment Fee.

All teams will be notified within 48 hours of the receipt of their application. Starting March 20th, applications will be evaluated based on team competitive strength, referee team experience, and date the application forms and fees were received. Acceptance of teams will be decided and teams will be **notified by March 26th**. Teams applying without a referee team will be placed on a waiting list.

If your team is accepted, it will be assumed that you intend for your team to play the entire tournament, and your referee team will complete their assigned games. If your team is not accepted, you will be offered the opportunity to be placed on a waiting list, or if you prefer we will return the entry/referee deposit fees submitted to your Region's Treasurer.

Refund after your team is accepted: If you withdraw your application 30 or more days from the start of the tournament, a full refund will be issued. If you withdraw after April 28th, you will only receive a refund if a replacement team can be found.

Teams are required to complete their team & player registration on Friday, May 27th at the Tournament Hotel to facilitate the start of play on Saturday morning. Players need not be present and the process can be completed by one coach or a designated team representative. The meeting will be held 6:30 – 9:30 PM at Country Inn & Suites by Carlson – San Diego North. Those teams not present on Friday night may forfeit their first game on Saturday.

ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY



I. AYSO POLICY REGARDING VOLUNTEER HARASSMENT

1. All teams and team supporters shall adhere to AYSO Policy regarding volunteer harassment in accordance with AYSO Policy Statement, Article II, Section 2.12

II. Four Positive Behavior Rules

In an attempt to encourage positive behavior and positive cheering at all Top Gun Soccer Tournament games, the 26th Annual Top Gun Soccer Tournament Committee has adopted the following four rules that is to be the standard at all Top Gun games and fields, by all teams and by all team supporters.

- 1. Referees......Will officiate the game
- 2. Coaches......Will coach the players
- 3. Players......Will play the game
- 4. Parents and all Supporters.....Will cheer for the players

III. Unacceptable Behavior

- 1. Any negative or harassing remark directed towards the Referees, Players, Coaches and Tournament Officials.
- 2. The standard is this: If you won't say it to someone you respect, then don't say it to...The Referees, The Players, the Coaches, the Tournament Officials or anyone at the tournament.

IV. Conduct

- 1. Coaches will be expected to set a positive example for the team, and will be held responsible for the actions of their team including spectators. All spectators must remain behind the control line and between the 18-yard lines. Teams may have a maximum of 2 coaches, and they must remain in the marked coaching area (within ten yards either way from midfield).
- 2. Referees are <u>required</u> to complete a game misconduct report for <u>all send off</u> misconducts during the game, as well as any incidents of interference by spectators.
- 3. Any ejected coach or spectator must immediately leave the vicinity of the playing field (out of sight and sound) and will be prohibited from attending the next scheduled game. Any player sent off (red carded) must immediately leave the vicinity of the game (under supervision of their parent or Safe Haven-certified adult), and may not return to the field of play during the current game, including for the post-game handshake, and may not be substituted for, and is suspended from participation in the next game. There will be penalty point deductions for all send-offs (see Tournament Rule 18: Standings).
- 4. Any send off for violent conduct red card or ejection will result in that player/coach/spectator being barred from the remainder of the tournament, and will be reported to the respective Regional Commissioner, Area 11R, and Section 11.
- 5. If it is determined that an ineligible player has participated in a game, the team will forfeit all games in which that player participated illegally. Furthermore, if it is determined that the coach knowingly played a player illegally, that coach will be barred from further participation in the tournament.
- 6. It is mandatory to play a scheduled game. If it is determined that a coach willfully fails to have his team participate in a scheduled game, the coach will be dismissed from the tournament and the incident will be reported to the respective Regional Commissioner.

- 7. All conduct problems will be reported to the respective Regional Commissioner. All Red Card suspensions not served at the tournament will be reported to the respective Regional Commissioner.
- 8. All Serious Incidents will be reported to the respective Regional Commissioner as well as Area, Section and AYSO National Office

V. Referee Teams

- 1. Referees from penalized teams must continue to officiate their scheduled games. Non-compliance or failure to complete assigned or scheduled duties will result in a forfeit of pre-paid Referee Deposit for the 26th Annual Top Gun Soccer Tournament. (AYSO Policy Statement, Article II-AYSO Activities, ss2.8,c,ii)
- VI. How to address Game Related Issues.
 - 1. Do not confront any Tournament Volunteers
 - i. Public Safety Officials will be called to assist any volunteer who feels threatened by team players, team officials and/or team supporters
 - 2. Let the Regional Commissioner or the Region Representative (Coach, Asst. Coach or Team Admin.) handle discussions concerning Top Gun Soccer Tournament, game issues.

- 2. Refusal to complete signatures or submit by March 19, 2016 will result in wait list status and team will not be accepted until all requirements are completed.


