Parent/Athlete Concussion Information Sheet



A concussion is a type of traumatic brain injury that changes the way the brain normally works. A concussion is caused by bump, blow or jolt to the head or body that causes the head and brain to move rapidly back and forth. Even a "ding," "getting your bell rung," or what seems to be a mild bump or blow to the head can be serious.

WHAT ARE THE SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS OF CONCUSSION?

Signs and symptoms of concussion can show up right after the injury or may not appear or be noticed until days or weeks after the injury.

If an athlete reports **one or more** symptoms of concussion listed

Did You Know?

- Most concussions occur *without* loss of consciousness
- Athletes who have, at any point in their lives, had a concussion have an increased risk for another concussion.
- Young children and teens are more likely to get a concussion and take longer to recover than adults.

below after a bump, blow, or jolt to the head or body, s/he should be kept out of play the day of the injury and until a health care professional, experienced in evaluating for concussion, says s/he is symptom-free and it's OK to return to play.

SIGNS OBSERVED BY COACHING STAFF	SYMPTOMS REPORTED BY ATHLETES
Appears dazed or stunned	Headache or "pressure" in head
Is confused about assignment or position	Nausea or vomiting
Forgets an instruction	Balance problems or dizziness

CONCUSSION DANGER SIGNS

In rare cases, a dangerous blood clot may form on the brain in a person with a concussion and crowd the brain against the skull. An athlete should receive immediate medical attention if after a bump, blow or jolt to the head or body s/he exhibits any of the following danger signs:

- One pupil larger than the other
- Is drowsy or cannot be awakened
- A headache that not only does not diminish, but gets worse
- Weakness, numbness, or decreased coordination
- Repeated vomiting or nausea
- Slurred speech
- Convulsions or seizures
- Cannot recognize people or places
- Becomes increasingly confused, restless, or agitated
- Has unusual behavior
- Loses consciousness (*even a brief loss of consciousness should be taken seriously*)

WHY SHOULD AN ATHLETE REPORT THEIR SYMPTOMS?

If an athlete has a concussion, his/her brain needs time to heal. While an athlete's brain is still healing, s/he is much more likely to have another concussion. Repeat concussions can increase the time it takes to recover. In rare cases, repeat concussions in young athletes can result in brain swelling or permanent damage to their brain. *They can even be fatal.*

Remember

Concussions affect people differently. While most athletes with a concussion recover quickly and fully, some will have symptoms that last for days, or even weeks. A more serious concussion can last for months or longer.

WHAT SHOULD YOU DO IF YOU THINK YOUR ATHLETE HAS A CONCUSSION?

If you suspect that an athlete has a concussion, remove the athlete from play and seek medical attention. Do not try to judge the severity of the injury yourself. Keep the athlete out of play the day of the injury and until a health care professional, experienced in evaluating for concussion, says s/he is symptom-free and it's OK to return to play.

Rest is key to helping an athlete recover from a concussion. Exercising or activities that involve a lot of concentration, such as studying, working on the computer, or playing video games, may cause concussion symptoms to reappear or get worse. After a concussion, returning to sports and school is a gradual process that should be carefully managed and monitored by a health care professional.

SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS

Athletes who experience one or more of the signs or symptoms listed below after a bump, blow, or jolt to the head or body may have a concussion.

SIGNS OBSERVED

- Appears dazed or stunned
- Is Confused about assignment or position
- Forgets an instruction
- Is unsure of game, score, or opponent
- Moves clumsily
- Answers questions slowly
- Loses consciousness (even briefly)
- Shows mood, behavior, or personality changes
- Can't recall events prior to hit or fall
- Can't recall events after hit or fall

SYMPTOMS REPORTED BY ATHLETE

- Headache or "pressure" in head
- Nausea or vomiting
- Balance problems or dizziness
- Double or blurry vision
- Sensitivity to light
- Sensitivity to noise
- Feeling sluggish, hazy, foggy, or groggy
- Concentration or memory problems
- Confusion
- Just not "feeling right" or is "feeling down"

SEEK IMMEDIATE MEDICAL ATTENTION FOR ANY OF THE FOLLOWING SYMPTOMS

- One pupil larger than the other
- Drowsiness or inability to wake up
- A headache that gets worse and won't go away
- Weakness, numbness or decreased coordination
- Repeated vomiting or nausea
- Slurred speech
- Convulsions or seizures
- Unusual behavior, confusion, restlessness or agitation
- Loss of consciousness

COACH ACTION PLAN

If you suspect that an athlete has a concussion, you should take the following four steps:

1. Remove the athlete from play.
2. Ensure that the athlete is evaluated by a health care professional experienced in evaluating for concussion. Do not try to judge the seriousness of the injury yourself.
3. Inform the athlete's parents or guardians about the possible concussion and give them the CDC fact sheet for parents on concussion.
4. Keep the athlete out of play the day of the injury and until a health care professional, experienced in evaluating for concussion, says they are symptom-free and it's OK to return to play.

ADDITIONAL AYSO COACH PROCEDURES

5. Submit AYSO Incident Report to Safety Director
6. Refer parents to the AYSO/CDC Information sheet and SAI information available at AYSO.org
7. Obtain signed AYSO Participation Release from Parent/Guardian prior to return to play
8. Obtain a Medical Release if required by State Law
9. Give all signed forms to your AYSO Safety Director

AYSO REFEREE ACTION PLAN

During a game, if there is any reason to suspect a concussion:

1. Whistle to stop play immediately.
2. Call the coach onto the field.
3. If safe, have the player leave the field to be checked for signs/symptoms. If any sign/symptoms are observed, the player must not play for the remainder of the day.
4. If signs/symptoms are observed after the player returns to play, remove player from the game.
5. File a supplemental game report of the incident with the appropriate AYSO authority.

REMEMBER, WHEN IN DOUBT, SIT THEM OUT.

ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY

I. AYSO POLICY REGARDING VOLUNTEER HARASSMENT

1. All teams and team supporters shall adhere to AYSO Policy regarding volunteer harassment in accordance with AYSO Policy Statement, Article II, Section 2.12

II. Four Positive Behavior Rules

In an attempt to encourage positive behavior and positive cheering at all Top Gun Soccer Tournament games, the 28th Annual Top Gun Soccer Tournament Committee has adopted the following four rules that is to be the standard at all Top Gun games and fields, by all teams and by all team supporters.

1. Referees.....Will officiate the game
2. Coaches.....Will coach the players
3. Players.....Will play the game
4. Parents and all Supporters.....Will cheer for the players

III. Unacceptable Behavior

1. Any negative or harassing remark directed towards the Referees, Players, Coaches and Tournament Officials.
2. The standard is this: *If you won't say it to someone you respect, then don't say it to...The Referees, The Players, the Coaches, the Tournament Officials or anyone at the tournament.*

IV. Conduct

1. Coaches will be expected to set a positive example for the team, and will be held responsible for the actions of their team including spectators. All spectators must remain on their teams side of the field, behind the control line, and between the 18-yard lines. Teams may have a maximum of 2 coaches, and they must remain in the marked coaching area (within ten yards either way from midfield).
2. Referees are required to complete a game misconduct report for all send off misconducts during the game, as well as any incidents of interference by spectators.
3. Any ejected coach or spectator must immediately leave the vicinity of the playing field (out of sight and sound) and will be prohibited from attending the next scheduled game. Any player sent off (red carded) must immediately leave the vicinity of the game (under supervision of their parent or Safe Haven-certified adult), and may not return to the field of play during the current game, including for the post-game handshake, and may not be substituted for, and is suspended from participation in the next game. There will be penalty point deductions for all send-offs (see Tournament Rule 18: Standings).
4. Any send off for violent conduct red card or ejection will result in that player/coach/spectator being barred from the remainder of the tournament, and will be reported to the respective Regional Commissioner, Area 11R, and Section 11.
5. If it is determined that an ineligible player has participated in a game, the team will forfeit all games in which that player participated illegally. Furthermore, if it is determined that the coach knowingly played a player illegally, that coach will be barred from further participation in the tournament.
6. It is mandatory to play a scheduled game. If it is determined that a coach willfully fails to have his team participate in a scheduled game, the coach will be dismissed from the tournament and the incident will be reported to the respective Regional Commissioner.
7. All conduct problems will be reported to the respective Regional Commissioner. All Red Card suspensions not served at the tournament will be reported to the respective Regional Commissioner.
8. All Serious Incidents will be reported to the respective Regional Commissioner as well as Area, Section and AYSO National Office

V. Referee Teams

1. Referees from penalized teams must continue to officiate their scheduled games. Non-compliance or failure to complete assigned or scheduled duties will result in a forfeit of pre-paid Referee Deposit for the 29th Annual Top Gun Soccer Tournament. (AYSO Policy Statement, Article II-AYSO Activities, ss2.8,c,ii)

VI. How to address Game Related Issues.

1. Do not confront any Tournament Volunteers
 - i. Public Safety Officials will be called to assist any volunteer who feels threatened by team players, team officials and/or team supporters
2. Let the Regional Commissioner or the Region Representative (Coach, Asst. Coach or Team Admin.) handle discussions concerning Top Gun Soccer Tournament, game issues.



Top Gun Tournament – No Pets Allowed

Mira Mesa Soccer – AYSO Region 285 and the Top Gun Tournament have a **NO** Pets Policy at all events held in our Region. We ask all parents, guests and spectators to leave your pets at home when you attend any AYSO event in our region including practices, games, picture day, opening ceremonies and tournaments.

This policy is endorsed by AYSO National as well as our Section and Area. This policy is in line with our insurance policy which does not cover animal bites or related injuries

Service animals as defined by the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) are exempt from this policy. **However**, we ask you visit our tents and inform the director of the presence of the service animal prior to the match.

PLEASE NOTE THAT SERVICE ANIMALS ARE DEFINED BY THE ADA AS: Dogs that are individually trained to so work or perform tasks for people with disabilities. Service animals are working animals, not pets. The work or task a dog has been trained to provide must be directly related tot eh person’s disability. Dogs whose sole function is to provide comfort or emotional support do NOT qualify as a service animal under the ADA. Any attempt to present a comfort or emotional support service animal or pet as a service dog is fraud and punishable under California Penal Code 365.7 with a maximum penalty of \$1,000.00 per instance and up to six months in jail.

29th Annual Top Gun Soccer Tournament AYSO Invitational -Tournament Rules

CATEGORY	RULE
1) JURISDICTION	<p>A. Unless otherwise noted, the current AYSO National Rules and Regulations, Section 11 and FIFA Laws of the game will be used for this tournament. The following rules are intended specifically for this tournament ONLY!</p> <p>B. The Tournament Committee (incl. Tournament Director, Assistant Director, Coach Administrator, Referee Administrator and other designated staff) will have jurisdiction over all games played. Disputes will be resolved by the end of the soccer day. Referee judgment calls are NOT subject to dispute or protest.</p>
2) FEES	<p>A. Entire fee and referee fee must accompany tournament application and will be returned if the team is not admitted as explained in paragraphs 3) – 5) below. Fees must be sent in a single check issued from the respective Region's account (NO PERSONAL CHECKS OR MONEY ORDERS).</p> <p>B. Fees for U10 (Birth year 2010-2009) are \$810 (entry fee \$435 plus referee deposit \$375),</p> <p>C. Fees for U12 (Birth year 2008-2007) are \$860 (entry fee \$485 plus referee deposit \$375),</p> <p>D. Fees for U14 (BY 2006-2005), U16 (BY 2004-2003), U19 (BY 2000) are \$875 (\$500 plus \$375)</p>
3) APPLICATION	<p>A. Teams are requested to provide an indication of their competitive strength and designate a team of three experienced referees on their tournament application forms. Referees should be comfortable working at least at the age level of the team they are representing.</p> <p>B. The deadline to apply to the tournament is March 20th, 2019. Applications received by that date will be given priority for acceptance into the tournament; all others will be accepted based on any available openings.</p> <p>C. All teams will be notified their application has been received within 48 hours of the receipt of their application.</p> <p>D. The primary form of communication between the Tournament and applying teams will be email and the Tournament website. Teams must designate a Team Contact on their application who has email and Internet access.</p>
4) ACCEPTANCE	<p>A. Starting March 20th, applications will be evaluated for team's competitive strength, referee team experience, and date the application forms and fees were received. Teams applying without a referee team will be placed on a waiting list.</p> <p>B. Acceptance of teams will be decided and teams will be notified by email by March 25th as to their acceptance status. Teams that are not accepted will be given the option of returning their application & fees or to be placed on the waiting list.</p> <p>C. The notification email will also request the teams to confirm the team's commitment to attend Top Gun 2019. Teams failing to confirm within 7 calendar days that they will attend may be replaced by one of the alternate teams.</p>
5) REFUNDS	<p>A. Teams withdrawing 30 days or more before the tournament will be issued a full refund.</p> <p>B. Teams withdrawing less than 30 days before the start of the tournament will only be issued a refund if a replacement team can be found.</p> <p>C. If the tournament is canceled and cannot be rescheduled a full refund will be issued.</p> <p>D. For teams that are eligible, referee deposit refunds will be mailed no later than 14 days after the end of the tournament. REFEREE DEPOSIT REFUNDS WILL NOT BE ON A PRORATED BASIS; EACH TEAM MUST COMPLETE ALL ASSIGNMENTS TO RECEIVE A REFUND.</p>
6) RAINOUT/ CANCELLATION	<p>A. Should the tournament be rained out on the original date, it will not be rescheduled. A full refund will be sent to all teams.</p>
7) PLAYERS/TEAMS	<p>A. Players on participating teams must be registered to play in AYSO, and have played in the 2018 season – All players must be registered in their respective region by no later than March 20, 2019 – NO EXCEPTIONS. Coaches are responsible to ensure all players meet eligibility requirements (table below). See exceptions in paragraphs B, C & D below.</p> <p>B. In Divisions U16 & U19 only, Guest AYSO Players are allowed (3 maximum per team). Divisions U14, U12 & U10 may not use Guest Players.</p> <p>C. Guest Players (players from an AYSO region different from the applying team's region) will be allowed for U16 and U19 teams. However, the Guest Players are required to have the approval of the Guest Player's Regional Commissioner and the Host Team Regional Commissioner. Approval will be recorded by submitting the Guest Player Form (available on the Tournament web site) along with the Team Roster Form.</p> <p>D. Teams will be disqualified from the tournament for exceeding three Guest Players or using non-approved Guest Players. Team fees and expenses will not be reimbursed if a team is disqualified.</p> <p>E. Only a Blue Sombrero tournament roster will be accepted. They must be approved and signed by the team's Regional Commissioner. A preliminary roster submitted with your application is required for your application to be processed. You are not required to submit a final roster until you are notified of your team's acceptance into the tournament as a Primary participant. All players and jersey numbers MUST BE ENTERED in GOTSOCGER.</p>

	<p>F. Roster changes may be submitted (with the approval of the Regional Commissioner); however, these changes must be submitted to and received by the Tournament Registrar prior to the tournament. There will be no roster changes allowed on first tournament day. Roster changes MUST BE ENTERED in GOTSOCCKER.</p> <p>G. Each player and coach must have a laminated identification card with name, picture, AYSO ID# and the signature of their Regional Commissioner. These ID cards must be presented for inspection at team registration time or upon request by any tournament official or match referee.</p> <p>H. COED teams will be accepted; however, they must play in the boy's divisions only. A player may only play on one team.</p> <p>I. All players must play at least half of each game. These coaches must be listed on the Official Team Roster.</p> <p>B. The Coaches must wear their laminated ID Card on a lanyard provided by the tournament at all times when they are coaching their team, and be able to present them upon request to any tournament or match official.</p> <p>C. 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17) SUBSTITUTIONS	<p>A. For divisions U10 through U14, substitutions shall be allowed approximately midway through each half and at halftime. 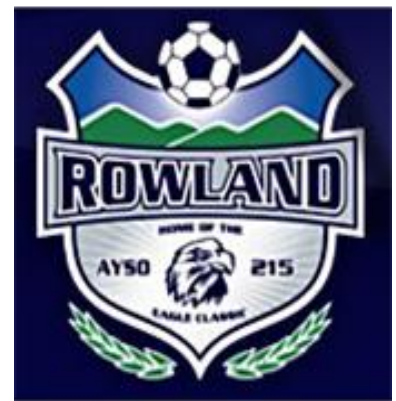
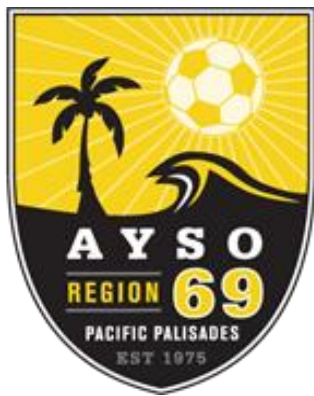
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
